#### TIP OF THE DAY

**'Seeing is believing' (visualisation)** - The brain, eyes and ears are there to be used by bowlers who want to be the best they can. Bowlers of all standards need to watch and learn from the best. (Extract "Winning becomes you in lawn bowls" by Lachlan Tighe)

My humble advice – Tune into some of the events mentioned above and on the internet to watch and analyse various aspects of our game:

• *Deliveries* – Every person delivers a bowl differently but each professional delivers the same way every time. Hone your delivery for consistency.

Compare what you see from professionals to your own delivery:

- o Do I take my time visualising before delivery?
- O Where do I stand on the mat?
- Where do I look to get a line?
- o Can I minimise body movement when delivering so I can repeat repeat, repeat?
- o How big is my step?
- o Do I stay low?
- **Reading the head** Often there's no right or wrong shot but there are various ways to read the head. Watch the professionals, think how you would play into the head, then see what shot the professional plays. You may both be right but the trick is to **determine what is the risk and what is the reward.**
