Scenario	Suggested answer
1 behind on the scoreboard	Play over the draw to land your bowl to push out the
What shot would you play?	 shot bowl or trail the Jack There is danger in playing too much weight.
Unable to determine the shot bowl. What shot would you call in this situation?	 Attack the head with weight to change the head and move the Jack from current location If you hit your bowl the Jack and opponent's bowls should move too.
